

How to submit an essay if you have not submitted after 2019

Step 1: Navigate to Submission Page and Create Account

- From the DNA Day Essay Contest homepage, follow the link to the submission site
- You will need to create an ASHG account. This is not a membership account and does not require payment.
- Complete all required fields
- If you are prompted to allow access for your email, you must select Allow to access the submission site.
- You will come to a page that asks you to add missing information to continue. In the Membership Type Section, please type "Not Available"

Step 2: Submit Essay

- Once you have created your account, you will be directed to the ASHG Account Portal Page. Find the DNA Day Essay Contest on this page and click "Submit Essay"
- You are now logged in and can move forward with submitting your essay(s)
- Complete all required fields. Required fields are indicated with a red star. If you do not complete a required question the system will notify you and not allow you to submit your essay.
- When moving from the Contact Information Page to the Entry Information Page, the site will save your contact information for future submissions.
- Please be sure to paste the essay in the Essay Section and the list of citations and references in the Citations/References Section.
- You will not be able to make changes after submitting. Please ensure all information, including school and student information, are correct.
- You may save the submission draft and return later to submit.

Step 3: Confirmation of Receipt

- Once your essay is submitted, you will be directed to a confirmation page and will receive a confirmation email from dnaday@ashg.org.
- The confirmation email will be sent to the teacher's email address provided in the Contact Information Section of the application.
- If you do not receive a confirmation email, please be sure to check your junk/spam folder.
- Your email confirmation is specific to that essay. If you submit more essays, you will receive separate emails for those essays.
